T H E PROJECT


The Project Purpose



Using participatory techniques and creating a context-driven and collaborative strategies for art making, the students, faculty and community play an active and meaningful role in developing and designing The Project for young artists to feel connected to themselves, to each other, to the Alabama Center for the Arts, to a college pathway and to art itself as a place of messy wildness.

That structure of The Project begins with building relationships to students by offering the day's plan with enthusiastic calm in a way that creates space for their input, to share what is interesting and curious about the activity, or ask questions about why we are doing what we're doing. The learning space is used in a way that opens people up to develop their own content and pursue their own desires. This co-creation is critical in participatory teaching techniques.

The Pathway to Higher Education



1. Fine Arts Camp—Is an intensive, 2-week, summer experience called, "The Project", students from high schools will work with faculty and professional artists on a collaborative performance project using all aspects of Fine and Performing Arts. Students will design and paint sets, write and act, produce and perform, create promotional materials and film the performance.

2. In the second stage of the pathway, students will enroll as fine/performing arts majors at Calhoun. The Fine Arts Pathway Program will provide support for classroom visits by professionals, career workshops, and job-shadowing experiences to enhance students' knowledge of careers and workforce development skills.

3. In the final stage of the pathway, students will enroll as fine/performing arts majors at Athens State. In their senior year, students will participate in professional internships, cooperatives, and senior capstone projects. These initiatives will contribute directly to student success and career development in the Fine and Performing Arts.
